Footnotes

BEPPIN drifted in at the start bumping ROYAL NATALIE, stalked the pace in hand, took over nearing the final quarter, quickly drew off under her own power and was in hand late. GIANTS' COOL CAT settled near the inside, fanned six wide into the lane and was clearly second best. BLUESTOCKING moved to the front early, made the pace until approaching the final quarter and weakened. MAINMAST, bumped at the start and shuffled back, was outrun to the lane and improved position while not a threat. PRINCESS KATHLEEN swerved out at the start, was six or seven wide on the first turn and not a threat while passing tired foes. LUXURIOUS LADY angled in early to force the pace, raced up close to the stretch and tired. GLORY NOW never was a factor. ROYAL NATALIE, bumped at the start by the winner and forced in, raced forwardly for six furlongs and tired. MEANMEANEMMAJEAN faded approaching the stretch.
