Supplementary nominations may be made by 12:00 PM Friday, August 22, 2008 by payment of \$2,500 (includes entry and starting fees). \$50,000 Guaranteed. The Association's money to be divided; 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 11% to third, 6% to fourth and 3% to fifth. Weights to be announced Saturday, August 23, 2008. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. If the race is moved to the main track after the time of closing, a horse may be scratched for any reason at any time until fifteen (15) minutes prior to post time of the race preceding this race or thereafter with a valid physical reason and approved by the stewards. The entry fee and supplementary nomination fee if applicable shall be refunded for scratches made in compliance with the above conditions. A trophy will be presented to the winning owner. Closed Saturday, August 16, 2008 with 30 nominations. (If deemed inadvisable by management to run this race over the turf course, it will be run on the main track at One mile out of the chute.).

GIN AND SIN settled in hand removed from the rail, ranged into contention three wide, reeled in the leader inside the furlong marker and edged clear through the final yards. VANQUISHER settled saving ground, closed the gap through the second turn along the inside, angled out to continue the rally and finished willingly to earn the place. VOY POR UNO MAS opened clear to set the pace, increased his advantage down the backstretch, but weakened during the drive and gave way. BRILLIANT BID was rank to place early, settled off of the pace leaving the first turn, came two wide to make his bid, but lugged in through the stretch and finished evenly. SELF MADE MAN was allowed to settle in mid pack three wide and failed to respond when called upon. REY DEL SOL showed little in a dull effort. PETION STATION saved ground to no avail.
