Footnotes

BROTHER'S BLUFF, outrun from early on, raced five wide on the backstretch, edged in around the turn, rallied from the rail into the stretch and won going away under intermittent urging. SHADY LADY JANE, bumped at the start, was sent to the fore soon after, raced three wide, lost the edge nearing the final quarter to ILLUSIVE PLAY from the outside, regained the advantage nearing the final furlong but wasn't a match for the winner thereafter. CIELO'S MISS settled inside early, came out advance from between rivals four wide into the stretch, loomed a solid threat for the last eighth and came up empty. ILLUSIVE PLAY drifted out at the start bumping TIMELESS LOVE and was checked, moved up soon after to stalk the pace four wide, reached the front approaching the stretch but faltered the last eighth. TIMELESS LOVE, bumped at the start and checked, angled inside early, moved between rivals on the far turn while advancing, angled out for the drive and came up empty. WAY MARIE, well placed for six furlongs, weakened thereafter. GEE SCOTT IT never menaced. RHYTHM IN JUNE was never prominent. QUICKWITCH came out at the start bumping SHADY LADY JANE, gave way before going a half, wasn't persevered with and was distanced.
