### Footnotes

JAMMIN JAVA sprinted clear early, raced three or four wide, made the balance of the pace and was kept to her task. PERFECT ONE, close up inside the winner early, moved outside the winner four wide nearing the stretch but couldn't menace in the drive as second best. PRINCESS IRIS came out bumping BARGAIN BETTY at the break, was outrun for a half, offered a mild gain. BARGAIN BETTY leaned in bumping with PRINCESS IRIS at the start, stalked the pace five wide into the final furlong and came up empty. SHAGSVILLE, outsprinted inside early, split foes four wide at the furlong grounds but couldn't muster the needed response. SHADY LADY JANE, well placed inside to the stretch, weakened in the drive. JEANIE'S TREAD was outrun.
