Footnotes

DANGEROUS GIRL settled inside early, was outrun for six furlongs, eased out five or six wide, continued six wide into the stretch and closed determinedly to be up in time. DOC'S HONEY settled inside, moved between foes three or four wide at the furlong grounds, angled to the rail a sixteenth out and was outfinished. LADY FROM SHANGHAI gained the lead inside, raced in the three patch, shook off JENNY LEE at the furlong grounds, then could not last. JENNY LEE tracked the pace four wide into the final furlong and flattened out when the test came. NAVAJO GIRL moved up early to force the pace three or four wide, raced forwardly for six furlongs and weakened. ESKIMO BABY, never far back while following the leaders five wide to the stretch, faltered in the drive. REGAL WAGER, carried out badly on the first turn, couldn't recover. AUGUST MOON DANCER, well placed for six furlongs while four or five wide, weakened thereafter. LIGAN'S BRAT bolted badly on the first turn carrying REGAL WAGER out in the process, nearly hit the outer railing, was eased before going a half and pulled up.
