DO ME A SOLID opened clear and angled in to set the pace, repelled the bid of LOTTA HEART entering the stretch and drew away. LOTTA HEART prompted the pace between horses, then along the inside, shifted out on the turn, moved up to engage DO ME A SOLID on the turn, was unable to match strides with that one but stayed on to earn the place. PURE LIGHT was unhurried into stride, got through and was making up ground too late. ISSHEIT was allowed to settle, came four wide and finished with a belated gain. SPICE OF LIFE was hustled along four wide through the turn and dropped out. PROM THEME failed to respond. AIDEN'S INDY was close up inside, was caught in tight when LOTTA HEART came in near the five-eighths pole, checked hard losing position, kept on fairly well but came up empty after a half.
