### Footnotes

LITTLE REALFIRE raced in behind horses early, moved five or six wide when put to a drive at the five-sixteenths pole, collared front-running PARTY LASS at the sixteenth pole and edged clear under strong handling. FOREVER SONIC, outrun early while three wide, came out eight wide at the quarter-mile ground to rally and finished willingly. CIMPLY SAVIO, unhurried inside for six furlongs, came out to rally from between rivals five or six wide into the stretch and offered a mild gain. PARTY LASS, well placed behind the leaders early, moved five wide at the far turn to rally, took over entering the upper stretch, then faltered late. TOO SASSY FOR U stalked the pace four or five wide in contending position into the stretch and was empty. RUTHLESS ONE failed to menace. BEAUTY'S DUE pressed the pace from the start, gained the lead at the end of the backstretch, made the pace until the stretch and weakened thereafter. LOMATIC gained a narrow advantage inside early, surrendered it to BEAUTY'S DUE before going a half, continued forwardly until the stretch and tired. BEANIE FINKLESTEEN forced the pace three or four wide from early on, gained about even terms for the lead while between rivals entering the stretch but tired soon after.
