Footnotes

SON OF THE WEST, bumped at the start by EASTERN FEVER, went up to vie for the lead from between foes, took over, edged clear, then held sway under urging. SPLENDID IN SPRING, never far back and five wide, had aim at the winner through the stretch and wasn't good enough. EASTERN FEVER leaned in bumping the winner at the start, raced within striking distance while in behind horses, moved four wide into the lane and offered a mild gain. Q MAC'S PHONE, outsprinted early, edged in around the turn, advanced five wide into the final furlong and was slowly gaining. HELL BROKE LOOSE, outrun to the stretch, found his best stride late. MASTER CHARGER contested the pace inside to the upper stretch and weakened. SHOT GUN CLIFF, outrun to the stretch, improved position but couldn't menace. BRILLIANT BID tired leaving the turn. RAZOR CAT forced the issue three abreast to the stretch and tired. ART AND SOUL, off the inside, tired early. HOT CASE never was close. SMOKEM SQUIRE was fractious in the gate and showed nothing.
