ROMANTIC CHANNEL set the pressured pace along the inside, edged clear nearing the furlong marker and widened. CASH AND COOKIES stalked the pace, moved up three wide to make a bold bid, but was unable to match strides with the winner. RARE SONG contended between horses, settled off the pace on the backstretch, lacked the needed late response and was all out to earn the show. COMMANDER BULL shifted out and moved up four wide to make a mild bid but failed to sustain the drive. SMOKIN FAST was allowed to settle four wide and failed to respond. RIO WYNN was never a factor. VICTORN broke slow and showed little.
