PHONE CHIMES sprinted clear, set the pace inside and increased her lead on her own courage. SWEET LULLABY forwardly placed, steadied midturn behind the winner then finished willingly to be second best. MILLION QUESTIONS broke slowly, advanced five on the turn then improved her position late. GOLDIE POPS unhurried off the inside was no real threat. SARAH'S MY ANGEL broke slowly, made an inside middle move but could not sustain the bid. LOMATIC forwardly placed off the inside, tired in the drive. COLOR ME CHROME five wide into the turn when within striking distance, tired. SUMMERHILL GAL outrun, raced six wide into turn and was no threat. TRISH'S AGENDA closest to early pace, steadied midturn when in tight and faded in the drive. TALKALOUD six wide into the turn when forwardly placed, faded. STEPPES close four wide, faded after a half.
