Footnotes

WILD DREAM hopped at the start, settled near the inside, saved ground into the stretch, came out to rally from between horses five wide at the sixteenth pole and wore down SLEW OF DEUCES. The latter, unhurried and racing inside, took over from the inside between calls in deep stretch, then couldn't contain the winner's surge. CATNIRO, in hand early while tracking the dueling leaders four wide, gained even terms for the lead at the furlong grounds but flattened out soon after. SUBROGATE, well placed, moved five wide at the quarter-mile ground but flattened out in the late stages. JOLEUR vied for the lead early while outside of SENOR CARLOS, gained the advantage on the far turn, held on into the final furlong and weakened. FLORAL RAJ (IRE), four or five wide most of the way, was empty in the drive. TRICKY TYLER failed to menace and was six or seven wide on the far turn. SENOR CARLOS gained a slim lead inside early, dueled with JOLEUR for nearly six furlongs and tired. MOUNTAIN BALLAD was outrun.
