Footnotes

GOLD TRAIN, forced out at the start by GREAT ATTITUDE, quickly settled, moved four or five wide, took over a quarter-mile out, then drew off in the lane under urging. MYTHICAL HUNTER, never far back while in behind horses, angled five wide into the stretch and was fully extended to earn the place. SARGEANT SILVER, between foes four wide, loomed menacingly in the drive and came up empty. HOLIDAY JUSTICE, outrun to the lane, improved position but wasn't a serious threat. LETTHEBIGTIMESROLL had no rally in an even effort. FITSIN, in behind foes early and in a forward position, flattened out in the drive. GREAT ATTITUDE broke sharply while bearing out badly, forced the winner out, raced in a striking position five wide and faltered in the drive. WILD POSSE passed tired foes. JOY FROM PHOENIX never was close. COWENS tired on the turn. WHY FLY gave way after a half and came wide into the final furlong.
