Footnotes

SILVER BAYER was allowed to settle, advanced between horses, angled out entering the stretch, reeled in DEATH VALLEY and edged clear late. DEATH VALLEY sped clear to set the pace, kept on well but was unable to resist the winner. RAHOO attended the pace three wide, offered a mild bid entering the stretch but lacked the needed late response. EXECUTIVE CHIEF contended along the inside, angled out leaving the turn but came up empty in the final furlong. SINGALONGWITH BERT settled saving ground, got through to make a mild rally but failed to threaten. JACK GRANT chased the pace two wide, but weakened from between rivals leaving the turn and faded. JAKE THE SNAKE dropped far back and passed only the tiring ones. CHARLIE'S ACADEMY was outrun. PALM SPRINGS showed little. BIGSURPRISEMISTER was hustled along four wide, but came up empty before going a half and dropped out.
