AEGISADVANTAGE pressed the pace two wide, forged command nearing the furlong marker and edged clear. WILDANDCRAZYGUY was away alertly and angled in to set the pace, was unable to match strides with the winner through the drive and was all out to hold the place. CLIFFORD'S JOY contended along the inside, angled out entering the stretch but was unable to improve position. UPPER CLASS POSH was unhurried into stride, circled five wide into the stretch and improved position. CHASE ME FOREVER was hustled along five wide and went evenly. HOMER T passed the tiring ones. SHANNON'S BEAU contended between horses to the stretch and faded. MICHAELS PARK was hustled along between horses in the second flight and was never a factor. HOMETOWN LEGEND was through early.
