Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. In the event this race is not divided it will be limited to 12 starters. Highweights preferred. In the case of ties, second preference to start will be given to those horses having accumulated the highest earnings in 2011-2012. A trophy will be presented to the winning owner. (If deemed inadvisable by management to run this race over the turf course, it will be run on the main track at One mile out of the chute.)

FINAL COUNT outrun off the inside, made a good middle move off the rail, dropped to the inside approaching the stretch, got through along the inside to challenge and drew off late under steady urging. BIG TOWN bobbled a bit at the start, was reserved for a half, moved closer three wide on the second turn, angled four wide into the stretch and finished willingly to be up for the place. FORTY NINE WATTS forced the pace off the inside, challenged in earnest before a half, gained a short lead on the second turn, stayed on well to the final furlong and tired. SUN BEAR close up along the inside, lacked a late bid. TILDEN LANE forwardly placed three wide, held on well to midstretch and tired. LAUGH IT OFF vied for the lead along the inside and stopped.
