STARRY STARRY NITE stalked the early leaders up the backstretch, took command entering the second turn and drew clear while under steady pressure. BERT'S BUBBLEADER forced the early pace just off the rail but could only chase the winner home. IRISH WARFARE unhurried early, rallied through the second turn, but flattened out late. RESIST RISK could pass only tired ones. FLYING BLIND AGAIN was never close and no threat. PROPER CIELO could offer no rally. MADISON'S HALO forced the pace outside and stopped.
