Footnotes

PAUSE FOR APPLAUSE, reserved near the inside early, continued inside when rallying into the lane, took over, drew clear and continued under solid hand urging. PRINCESS ANGELINE tracked front-running PEERLESS NOTE from early on while four wide, moved with the winner while outside that one entering the lane and couldn't match strides as second best. GOUGE, unhurried early, raced in behind horses, made a run from the rail entering the final furlong but couldn't sustain the needed momentum. MAMA I'M HOME, well placed early, dropped back last before going a half, trailed to the stretch and improved position off the inside. FANCY ROSE, well placed five wide into the final furlong, came up empty. MAMBO QUEST tracked the pace four or five wide to the stretch and weakened. ITERATION failed to menace. JET BLACK MAGIC was outrun. PEERLESS NOTE sprinted clear early, raced two or three wide, made the pace for six furlongs and had nothing left.
