LOOKN BOLDN BRASSY, bumped at the start by MAYBE KATIE and steadied, was unhurried, commenced a sweeping five wide rally leaving the backstretch, took over leaving the eighth pole and drove clear under urging. PUT THE HEAT ON gained a slim led near the inside early, battled into the final furlong and wasn't a match for the winner late. VICE ORR VERSA, outrun for six furlongs, made a mild gain along the inside. READY FIRE AIM, well placed between foes four wide, was empty when the test came. TWO CONDOS, reluctant to load into the gate, raced forwardly five wide to the stretch and tired. SOUTH MAGNOLIA dueled for the lead four wide into the stretch and weakened. RUBIANO'S REVENUE raced near the inside and tired. MAYBE KATIE came out at the start bumping the winner and tired on the far turn. MOODY KLAIR never menaced.
