FELA KUTI was shuffled back and unhurried into stride, responded when roused with three furlongs to run, angled out four wide entering the stretch, finished full of run and kicked clear. DRAGONFISH settled in hand along the inside, moved up through the second turn, angled out three wide and forged command nearing the furlong marker, kept on well but was unable to match strides with the winner. HIDDEN PUNCH pressed the pace between horses, weakened slight following a prolonged drive but had enough left to earn the show. BABYLON set the pressured pace three wide to the stretch and faded. RIVER CITY GEM was forwardly placed along the inside, drifted out through the second turn and retreated. STEW BOY was close up four wide for five furlongs and dropped out. COUNT ON GOLD was outrun.
