Footnotes

DEVILOFARUSH settled near the inside early, edged up around the turn, angled four wide for the drive and was going under strong handling to prevail. LEAD THE LAUNCH gained a narrow lead two or three wide early, made the pace into deep stretch and failed to contain the winner's surge. RAYWICK, outsprinted early and four wide, moved wider into the lane and could gain only slightly. DEPUTY'S CASE, well placed three or four wide into the final furlong, came up empty. DICK G chased the pace four or five wide into the stretch and tired. PETE'S DINER raced forwardly for three furlongs while four or five wide and faded.
