LEIGHANNA ROSE was unhurried into stride, tucked in to save ground, got through entering the stretch, finished with a rush and edged clear late. NOT A LADY hopped at the start to get away behind her field, was unhurried into stride, circled five wide, poked her head in front with a furlong to run, but was unable to match strides with the winner late. GRIPEY SARAH set the pressured pace three wide, weakened during the drive but had enough left to hold the show. LADY LANNIS was allowed to settle, angled out five wide and was making up some ground late. HONEY C broke sharp, was allowed to settle, made a mild rally between horses but failed to threaten. ROMAN INNOCENCE pressed the pace four wide, but came up empty in the final furlong and faded. REQUITAL pressed the pace off of the inside, came up empty between horses entering the stretch and faded. BLUE JEANS N BOOTS was away slow, rushed to contention between horses, but was used up before going a half and dropped out.
