MUD CREEK settled in hand, ranged up three wide through the second turn, forged command and edged clear. RED CARPET LADY pressed the pace two wide, was unable to match strides with the winner but stayed on well to earn the place. UP AND AWAY was away alertly to set the pace, weakened entering the stretch but had enough left to hold the show. MODEL'S MEMO was unhurried into stride and was never a factor. EXCELLENT RATE was through early.
