PACIFIC NIGHTS pressed the pace three wide, forged command with five-sixteenths to run, shook clear and maintained a safe advantage. PETER LOUIS made a long drive circling five wide, kept on well but was unable to reach the winner. GOSPEL HOUR was close up three wide, weakened from between horses but had enough left to hold the show. CARJON CARJON was slow into stride, dropped far back, angled out to make a belated gain but was left with too much to do. GRANDSTAND was allowed to settle, moved up between horses to make a mild bid but failed to sustain the drive. BIZARRO set the pressured pace along the inside, was headed midway through the second turn and gave way readily. LIGHT OF THE STORM failed to respond. BIEDERMAN was forwardly placed along the inside to the second turn and dropped out. NETWORK NEWS dropped far back and was always outrun. BENNY BOY was through after a half.
