**Footnotes**

TWO SEAT PETE prompted the pace along the inside, settled off of the pace through the second turn, angled out to launch his bid with a quarter to run, dropped back to the inside for the drive and wore down TIP TOP H. A. T. following a prolonged drive. TIP TOP H. A. T. attended the pace four wide, ranged up to engage the leaders with five-sixteenths to run, forged command leaving the second turn, kept on willingly but was unable to resist the winner. E DREAMER was allowed to settle, advanced between horses through the second turn, came three wide and was along in time to earn the show. MAJARTI settled in the second flight, made a mild bid circling five wide but failed to sustain the drive. RAY JAY set the pressured pace three wide, opened clear after a half, was collared leaving the second turn and gave way readily once headed. PITAYA was forwardly placed off of the inside for six furlongs and faded. ROYALTY AT LAST passed only his tiring rivals. HASTY K PERMIT failed to respond. MAYOFWHICHYEAR saved ground to no avail. WILLIE'S TURN was always outrun. SILVER GLASS was allowed to settle, went wrong nearing the furlong marker, drifted out and eased to the wire and was vanned off.
