Footnotes

COOL LION tracked the pace four deep, drew even leaving the second turn, wore down WHYWHY C AT and gradually edged clear. WHYWHY CAT pressed the pace three wide, forged a narrow lead with a quarter to run, continued on well but was unable to resist the winner. BADGER BARRY attended the pace tucked in along the rail, shifted out and bid between horses entering the stretch, kept on willingly and was making up ground steadily. DEVIL'S APPRENTICE was unhurried into stride, made a late rally circling five wide but was left with too much to do. GRAND DADDY contended between horses, was carried out entering the stretch and lacked a response when called upon. JUMP START NOW was allowed to settle, ranged up five wide to offer a mild bid leaving the second turn but failed to sustain the drive. CROWN THE CHIEF set the pressured pace along the inside, was headed after five furlongs and gave way readily thereafter.
