Footnotes

IRISH HARMONY was never far back, moved up quickly to engage the leaders nearing the three-eighths marker, opened a clear lead in mid-stretch and was all out to hold the winner safe late. GOTADOWATSISIDTOO was bumped at the start, lacked early speed, raced far wide through the turn and was getting to the winner late. APPASSIONATO STORM chased the leaders from the outside throughout and lacked the needed closing response. REASON TO RECKON was bumped and pinched back at the start, saved ground into the lane and finished with some late run. KID HUEY was hustled along to set a pressured pace from the inside and gave way after five furlongs. NICK'S GOLD raced off the leaders from the inside and failed to rally when called upon. DEPUTY MACKENZIE showed no early speed, saved ground throughout and did not reach contention. COUNTRY LEDO was void of early speed, raced wide through the turn and was not a factor. HOLYSTACK was away alertly to press the pace from the outside and weakened after going three furlongs.
