Footnotes

PANATELA was away alertly to duel for the early advantage from between foes, opened a clear lead with a furlong to run and held sway to the wire. SAY WHAT broke sharply to duel for the lead from the outside, drifted out into the lane and could not match strides with the winner late. BOLSHOI BALLET showed no early speed, raced off the rail into the lane, moved inside nearing the sixteenth pole and finished with good energy. TRIPLE TEE was bumped at the start, chased the leaders from the outside and gradually gave way. FANTASYVILLE was bumped at the start, lacked early speed, raced far wide through the turn and did not threaten. MONDAY MYSTERY was bumped at the start, raced off the leaders early, moved outside through the turn and was not a factor. COCONUT TELEGRAPH lacked early speed, raced off the rail throughout and failed to menace. TROPIC BUNNY raced off the leaders from the inside and weakened after going three furlongs.
