STEPHANIE PLUM was away alertly to duel for the early advantage from the outside, opened a clear margin with a quarter to run and drew off through the lane. MAJESTIC HALO lacked early speed, raced wide through the turn and finished with good energy to gain the place. MISS KELSO was off a step slow then hustled along to duel for the lead from the inside and gave way through the final furlong. CHIPS INDY SALSA was never far back, raced wide through the turn and lacked the needed closing response. THE LORDS LONGSHOT was void of early speed, raced off the rail throughout and did not reach contention. MT PEAK broke awkwardly, raced wide through the turn and was not a factor. ROSES IN THE SKY showed no early speed, raced far wide through the turn and did not offer a bid. THANK YOU WILL DO hopped at the start and was bumped, duelled for the lead from between rivals and weakened after going a half.
