BURR TANGO broke sharply then was hustled along to open a clear margin before going a quarter, saved ground while setting the pace and drew off through the lane. MO'EM DOWN raced off the pacesetters early, moved outside through the turn and finished with a steady rally. RUN ATOM chased the leaders from the inside throughout and lacked the needed closing response. FREEDOMSLASTKNIGHT chased the leaders from the outside and gradually gave way. WILD HOSS hesitated at the start, raced off the leaders early, moved outside through the turn and failed to rally. SHAME ON EM was void of early speed, raced wide through the turn and was not a factor. DEADWOOD SAGE lacked early foot, saved ground throughout and did not threaten. BEBE CHRISSY showed no early speed, raced off the rail throughout and did not reach contention.
