YAKUTAT broke in stride to take command at once, opened a clear lead before going a quarter, raced off the rail while setting the pace and held sway to the wire. CLEAR TO CANADA lacked early speed, saved ground through the turn, angled out into the stretch and finished with good energy. SNOW ON THE RIVER was never far back, raced wide through the turn and lacked the needed closing response. GOLD HARBOR chased the leaders from the inside and gradually gave way. CYBER BELL lacked early foot, angled outside nearing the quarter and failed to rally. CRESENT MCGAIN broke awkwardly, lagged, raced wide through the turn and did not reach contention. HUMONGOUS chased the leaders from the outside for three furlongs and weakened.
