RENAISSANCE QUEEN was away alertly to duel for the lead from the outside, responded when set down into the lane, vied with HAVE'N A WILD TIME through a prolonged drive and proved best. HAVE'N A WILD TIME pressed the pace from the far outside, moved up to engage the winner nearing the quarter and just missed through a hard drive. MUST BE GOLD was bumped at the start, showed no early speed, raced far wide through the turn and finished with a steady bid. WEDGE OF GOLD raced off the pacesetters early, moved outside through the turn and finished with good energy. ADAYFORPICKNDAISYS raced off the leaders from the inside throughout and failed to rally when clear. SWEET PLEASURE dueled for the lead from the inside for a half and weakened. A YEAR OFTHE COINS broke sharply to duel for the lead from between foes and also weakened after a half.
