**Footnotes**

FOUNTAIN RIDGE stalked the pace racing in hand, ranged up four wide to launch a bold bid, forged a narrow lead nearing the furlong marker, and gradually edged clear under stern urging. SOON BE GONE attended the pace racing three wide from between horses, continued on willingly through a prolonged drive, but was unable to match strides with the winner late. LIZAWATHA dueled for the lead racing along the inside, weakened slightly during the drive, but had enough left to hold the show. DINOS DASHOFSUGAR dueled for the lead racing two wide, but flattened out entering the stretch and gave way. SISTER ISABEL chased the pace racing four wide, offered a mild bid leaving the turn, but failed to sustain the drive. COUNTRY BASKET trailed.
