Footnotes

BLAME THE JOCKEY was bumped at the start, stalked the leaders from the inside, angled out nearing the three-eighths pole, gained command with a furlong to run and quickly drew off. NEWFOUND GOLD was away alertly to press the pace from the outside, dropped back nearing the three-eighths pole, responded to steady encouragement and came back to gain the place. RICKY RICKY was bumped at the start, raced off the leaders from the inside, angled out in mid-stretch and finished with good energy. MICHAEL MYERS was bumped at the start, set a pressured pace from the outside and gave way through the final furlong. LT. MARINO broke sharply to chase the leaders from the outside and gradually gave way. SHAKIN SHAMUS lacked early speed, raced wide through the turn and did not threaten. DACEY DEAL lacked early speed, saved ground throughout and did not reach contention. CERTIFIED DIAMOND stumbled at the start and was bumped, raced off the leaders throughout and gradually weakened. TIZBALASHI showed no early speed, raced far wide through the turn and was not a factor.
