GAVEL broke sharply to duel for the lead from between foes, vied with VICKYS FAST BOY into deep stretch and edged away from that rival late. VICKYS FAST BOY was away alertly to duel for the lead from the outside, could not stay with the winner in the drive but held on well to be clearly second best. SILVER MENCH was never far back while racing along the inside and finished willingly in the drive. MR. THIMBLE chased the leaders from the outside, drifted in and out in mid-stretch and finished evenly. HE'S ALL HEART raced off the leaders from the outside throughout and lacked the needed closing response. NICKEL NICKEL raced off the rail throughout and failed to rally. WHY IAN lacked early speed, raced wide through the turn and did not menace. REKLESENDANGERMENT hopped at the start, saved ground throughout and did not reach contention.
