STOLEN RIO was away alertly to duel for the lead from the outside, responded when set down for the drive and drew clear late. GIVAJUNIOR MINT dueled for the lead from the inside with the winner and gave way to that rival through the final furlong. SEVENTEENMILEDRIIVE raced off the pacesetters early, moved outside through the turn and finished with a steady rally. DODGER was never far back while racing along the inside, angled out nearing the quarter and lacked the needed closing response. WILDCAT TRUST lacked early speed, raced off the rail throughout and finished with some late run. RICKERSGETTINANGRY broke in the air, rushed to contend, pressed the pace from the outside and weakened after going a half. OVER AND UNDER was void of early foot, raced wide through the turn and did not menace. VOLTAR hesitated at the start, raced far wide through the turn and did not reach contention.
