**Footnotes**

ONE DOWN ONE TO GO was away alertly to press the pace from the outside, moved up to take command into the lane and steadily drew clear. SPECIAL NEGOTIATOR broke sharply to set a pressured pace from the inside, could not stay with the winner late but held on well to save the place. BRUIN BENCH stalked the leaders from the outside throughout and finished with good energy. DEVILISH FACT was never far back while racing from off the rail, angled inside nearing the eighth pole, bumped with HAVIN A GOOD DAY and lacked racing room to the wire. HAVIN A GOOD DAY raced off the pacesetters from the inside, was bumped and steadied nearing the eighth pole and lost his best chance. WEST SEATTLE BOY lacked early speed, moved between foes into the lane and failed to threaten. YASOU showed no early speed, raced off the rail throughout and did not menace. SEA SPEAKER was void of early speed, raced far wide through the turn and was not a factor. The Stewards conducted an inquiry concerning the bumping and steadying of HAVIN A GOOD DAY at the eighth pole and after reviewing the films concluded DEVILISH FACT had come over bumping and causing HAVIN A GOOD DAY to steady and that SPECIAL NEGOTIATOR had drifted in and caused DEVILISH FACT not to have ample running room and disqualified both SPECIAL NEGOTIATOR and DEVILISH FACT.
