**Footnotes**

NOOSA BEACH was away alertly to press the pace from the inside, angled out nearing the three-eighths marker, gained a slight edge with a quarter to run and held off his stable-mate in the drive to gamely prevail. WINNING MACHINE was never far back, moved up from between rivals nearing the quarter, reached the winner nearing the furlong pole but could not get by that rival through a prolonged drive. ZAGREUS lacked early speed, raced off the rail into the lane and finished with good energy. SIBERIAN COCKTAIL broke sharply to set a pressured pace from the inside and gave way after going a half. WASSERMAN bobbled at the break, lagged early, raced wide through the turn and did not threaten. STARBIRD ROAD pressed the pace from the outside and weakened after a half.
