SOUTHERN SOLUTION broke sharply to duel for the early advantage from the inside, responded when set down for the drive and proved best over PRIVATE PASSWORD through a prolonged game effort. PRIVATE PASSWORD was away in good order to duel for the lead from the outside, also responded when set down into the lane and grudgingly gave way to the winner late. RYANS ARGUMENT was never far back, raced wide through the turn, reached a contending position into the stretch but failed to gain in the drive. IMPUREGOLD broke awkwardly, showed no early speed, raced far wide through the turn and did not threaten. BIG QUESTION dueled for the lead from between rivals and weakened after going a half. HARBOR STAR lacked early speed, lugged out through the turn, steadied and did not menace thereafter.
