Footnotes

OUR BLEND was away in good order to set a pressured pace from the inside, responded when headed by MURRAY THE COP nearing the five-sixteenths marker and came back to be going away from that rival late. MURRAY THE COP chased the winner from the outside, moved up to engage that foe nearing the five-sixteenths pole, gained a slight edge between calls but could not match strides with that rival through the final yards. CRESCENT BAR was bumped at the start, lacked early speed, raced wide through the turn and finished with good late interest. ASUMMERPROSPECT was never far back, raced wide through the turn, angled out into the stretch and finished evenly in the drive. SPENDING was void of early foot, raced far wide through the turn and found his best stride late. FASTEST bobbed at the break, raced just off the leaders from the outside and failed to rally. SHUDDLE was bumped at the start, pressed the pace from the inside for three furlongs and weakened. SALSA BOY was off slow, lagged early and did not reach contention. SHAME THE DEVIL was bumped at the start, pressed the pace from between rivals and weakened after the opening quarter.
