MY MANS NO LADY was off a step slow, rushed to contend, set a pressured pace, opened a clear margin into the lane and was all out to hold off the closing EMANCIPATED. EMANCIPATED raced off the pacesetters early, moved far outside through the turn and was gaining on the winner late. R J'S PROSPECT showed no early speed, raced wide through the turn, angled out further in mid-stretch and finished with good late energy. HUMONGOUS was void of early speed, saved ground into the stretch, altered course nearing the sixteenth pole and finished evenly thereafter. HAVIN A GOOD DAY chased the leaders from the outside for a half and weakened. MARQUETCHING broke sharply to press the pace from between rivals and also weakened after going a half. The rider of HUMONGOUS lodged an objection against MY MANS NO LADY concerning the altering course of his mount nearing the sixteenth pole and after reviewing the films the stewards made no change.
