Footnotes

AROUND AND ABOUT dueled along the rail, shook EMERALD ACRES nearing the five-sixteenths pole, open a clear advantage in the upper stretch, and was kept to task to maintain a safe margin. MAH RITAZ permitted to settle into stride early, angled in to save ground, closed readily through the bend, slipped between foes entering the lane and finished well to just be up for the place. ANNIE'S BOU PEEP stalked the dueling leaders through the opening half, closed the gap into the lane, was blocked with three-sixteenths to run, got through inside the furlong marker, and made a steady advance. NOTO PONUS hustled along on the inside, ranged up to make a mild bid with a quarter to run, but failed to sustain the drive. ROYAL RULING swung six wide into the lane, and made a mild late improvement. DYNAMATCH went four wide throughout, and came up empty entering the stretch. EMERALD ACRES dueled from the outside, but was used up after a half and dropped back fast.
