LASTING CODE stalked the pace while racing in hand, moved up three-wide nearing the quarter pole, took the lead entering the stretch and gradually increased her advantage. STRONG CREDENTIALS disputed the pace from along the outside of IPPODAMIA, took the lead from that one nearing the quarter pole, was unable to resist the winner, but lasted for the place. DOUBLE QUACK allowed to settle in stride, came three-wide into the stretch and was making up ground late. MIDNIGHT LIGHTNING was between horses on the turn and lacked the needed late response. IPPODAMIA saved ground dueling for the lead to the stretch and tired. BOGUS PLAN unhurried early, came three-wide into the stretch and failed to menace. MUSIC TO MY HEART saved ground to the stretch, then drifted out badly during the drive and gave way. DIXIELIERE was outrun.
