Footnotes

GOTADOWATSISIDTOO was bumped at the start, stalked the leaders from the outside, responded to steady handling and wore down NICK'S GOLD in the drive to prevail. SUN LIGHTNING raced off the leaders from the inside, angled out nearing the quarter and finished with good energy. NICK'S GOLD was away alertly to set a pressured pace from off the rail and gave way through the final furlong. TRAVEL WITH BECK pressed the pace from the inside throughout and lacked the needed late response. CANVASBACK COVE was bumped at the start, steadied nearing the three-eighths pole, raced off the rail into the stretch and finished evenly. MARISHEK lacked early speed, raced wide through the turn, angled out in mid-stretch and failed to menace. AQABA was bumped at the start, raced off the leaders early, moved outside through the turn and gradually weakened. DEPUTY MACKENZIE lagged throughout, raced wide through the turn and did not reach contention.
