### Footnotes

BROKER RON stalked the pace of HOLYSTACK from the outside, moved up to take command with three-sixteenths to run and steadily drew clear. COCO'SPRIVATELABEL bobbled at the break, saved ground into the stretch and finished with good energy. HOLYSTACK went to the front at once, opened a clear lead before going a quarter, saved ground while setting the pace and gave way in the drive. IMNOCUPCAKE was bumped at the start, chased the leaders from the outside and lacked the needed closing response. RIVER STORM was bumped at the start, raced wide through the turn and did not menace. DELTA DIABLO was never far back while racing from between foes, steadied nearing the five-sixteenths marker and did not menace thereafter. AQABA showed no early speed, raced wide through the turn and did not threaten.
