AVRAM was away alertly to set a pressured pace from off the rail, opened a clear lead nearing the three-eighths marker and held sway to the wire. CAT ON BASE chased the leaders from the outside, was pushed out nearing the seven-sixteenths pole, moved inside through the turn and finished with good energy. I TOLD YOU TWICE was away alertly to chased the leaders from the outside, drifted out nearing the seven-sixteenths marker, raced wide into the lane and finished with good courage. HE'S FLYIN HOME raced off the leaders early, moved far outside through the turn and found his best stride late. GO BYE pressed the pace of the winner from the inside, steadied nearing the three-eighths pole, angled out and gave way in the drive. MR BERNIE B lacked early speed, saved ground throughout and did not threaten. MAKINYOURMARK showed no early speed, steadied nearing the seven-sixteenths pole, moved between foes nearing the quarter and was not a factor. THATS COWBOY lacked early foot, raced wide through the turn and lacked the needed closing response. BIG DADDY'S VISION was void of early speed, checked nearing the seven-sixteenths marker, raced wide through the turn and did not reach contention. The trainer of GO BYE lodged an objection against I TOLD YOU TWICE and after reviewing the films the Stewards made no change.
