Footnotes

BUDDY DAVE was away alertly to stalk the pace from the outside, moved up to off a bid nearing the eighth pole, bumped with SPECIAL RESERVE nearing the sixteenth marker and drew clear late. SPECIAL RESERVE went to the front soon after the start, opened a clear lead before going a quarter, saved ground while setting the pace, bumped with the winner nearing the sixteenth pole and gave way through the final yards to that rival. SPUD raced off the leaders early, moved outside through the turn and finished with a solid late rally. STORM DUKE was never far back while racing from between foes and gradually gave way. ISEEISAYOUPAY was void of early speed, raced wide through the turn and passed tiring foes late. WHISKEYANDRYE lacked early foot, saved ground throughout and did not menace. WINDYS MR P showed no early speed, steadied nearing the seven-sixteenths pole, moved outside through the turn and was not a factor. CZECHMAN MATADOR chased the leaders from the inside and weakened after going a half.
