Footnotes

HARDBODY was never far back while racing from between rivals, moved up from the outside to offer a bid nearing the quarter and drew off through the lane to score with complete authority. CHIPS INDY SALSA raced off the pacesetters early, moved far outside through the turn and finished with a steady rally. QUACK UP disputed the pace from the outside and gave way in the drive. PEAKABOOT TURN broke sharply to duel for the lead from off the rail and gave way through the final furlong. NAUGHTICAL (GB) chased the leaders from the inside, lacked racing room in mid-stretch, angled out and finished evenly thereafter. BRATS BRAT was void of early speed, raced off the rail throughout and failed to menace. ROXO raced off the pacesetters early, moved far outside through the turn and lacked the needed rally. MARY JEANENE showed no early foot, raced wide through the turn and did not reach contention.
