SARBONNE dueled for the early advantage from the inside, opened a clear margin nearing the quarter and drew off through the lane. MO'EM DOWN was away alertly to chase the winner from the outside, could not gain on that foe in the drive but was clearly second best. JAMES was bumped at the start, chased the leaders from the outside and gradually gave way. RUN ATOM broke sharply to duel for the lead from the outside and gave way to the winner after going three furlongs. SNOOPER DAUPER was void of early speed, raced wide through the turn and failed to threaten. TIMELY NOTE was bumped at the break, raced off the pacesetters from the inside throughout and lacked the needed rally. LAACHEM was void of early foot, raced wide through the turn and did not reach contention. G TEN raced off the leaders from between foes and gradually weakened. WILD W B T lagged throughout.
