MAID IN THE MOON sped clear at once to set all of the pace and remained unchallenged. MICHELLE'S CAP settled racing in hand, made her rally leaving the turn, was no threat to the winner, but finished willingly to prove second best. PLAYDEMROCKS was unhurried early and saved ground, swung six wide entering the lane to make a late rally, closed well but was left with too much to do. SISTER ADIBA settled saving ground, slipped through to make a late rally, but failed to seriously threaten. ASUMMERFORWINDY made a mild late gain circling four wide. SKYLAR MAY was hustled along to make a mild bid ran between horses on the turn, but failed to sustain the drive. BELLE TOWNE contended racing between horses early, but was through after a half. REASONFORREJECTION showed brief foot racing between horses, but was through early and dropped far back.
