SUNSHINE IN RIO sprinted clear at once, saved ground while setting the pace and was ridden out to the wire to increase his advantage. DROP VOLLEY was never far back while racing along the inside, checked nearing the quarter, angled out into the stretch, was no match for the winner in the drive but clearly second best. SPIT AND SHINE chased the winner from the outside throughout and gradually gave way. LITTLE ABE broke slow and awkward, lagged early, raced wide through the turn and found his best stride late. MINERS NIGHT broke sharply to chase the leaders from the outside and weakened after going a half. FREEDOM HOUSE lacked early foot, saved ground throughout and did not reach contention. MAJOR INCIDENT raced off the pacesetters from the outside and gradually weakened.
